Our most important tips on how to use your Evoke Spot

Before operating the product, always consult the Evoke Spot [User Guide](#) as well as the [Quick Start Guide](#). You can find both in our Download Center.

Before we start, we state the obvious. Please make sure your Evoke Spot is properly connected to a power source. Make sure that the antenna is fully extended, and all plastic covers are removed.

Switching Evoke Spot on/off

Pressing the Volume on/off button will boot your Evoke to the last source listened. When your Evoke is turned on for the first time, it runs through a [setup wizard](#) to configure settings for date/time and network. Once this has finished, the system is ready to use in most modes.

Saving or recalling a preset

The Evoke Spot offers two methods to save presets. These can either be saved to one of the 4 quick preset buttons or added to the preset list.

Pressing one of the quick preset buttons until "**Preset stored**" appears, will save the station currently listened to. Short press the preset button to recall it. More details can be found [here](#).
