Neither the manufacturer's nor the legal warranty usually differentiate between A-Stock (new goods) and B-Stock.* Should the manufacturer's warranty begin with the first use of an item rather than the date of purchase, this can be found in the product information.

*exception is the UK, where the warranty for B articles is 1 year $\,$
