## You would like to search for DAB+ radio stations and select them on your Elan One<sup>2</sup>?

When you power on your Elan One<sup>2</sup> for the first time, the unit will enter a DAB scan automatically. All available stations are found and saved in the "**Station list**".

1. To change the DAB station, press one of the "**Stations**" buttons (skip fwd/skip bwd) to open the "**Station list**".
2. You can now scroll through the available stations by pressing one of the skip buttons.
3. A single press will move one-by one, whereas holding a skip button pressed will run through the available.
4. Once you've found the station of your choice, press the "**Volume/Select**" dial to switch to that station.

For a new scan simply press the "**Menu/Back**" button while being in DAB mode, select the option "**Full Scan**" and confirm by pressing the "**Volume/Select**" dial.

Your radio will then delete all stored DAB stations and automatically begin scanning for all available stations.

Use the "**Prune invalid**" function to delete stations no longer available.
