How to change the EQ settings on a Classic Stereo?

You would like to change the EQ audio settings on your Classic Stereo?

- 1. To reach the EQ settings on the Classic Stereo, press the "**Home**" button on the main unit, or your remote.
- 2. Enter the "System settings" and choose "Equaliser".
- 3. Confirm by pressing the "**Volume/Select**" dial/button.
- 4. You can now select from Dynamic, Comfort, Neutral, Night, Custom EQ and the option to personalise your sound using the "Custom EQ Setting".
- 5. Entering the "Custom EQ Setting" allows you to manually set **Bass** and **Treble**, and to select **Loudness** On/Off.

You can also reach the EQ using the "**EQ**" button on your remote control.

Repeatedly pressing the "**EQ**" button lets you toggle through the different modes.

Pressing the "Night" button will directly activate the night mode.

The different modes are:

Dynamic - Deep bass extension - dynamic vocals and instruments

Comfort - Easy listening all day

Neutral - Sound as close to the source material

Night - Prevent sudden increases in Bass and Treble

Custom EQ - Define your own character with Bass and Treble controls
